



GEORGIA COYOTE CHALLENGE

Disposal of coyote carcasses:

Coyotes will be returned to participant once submission is complete. Participant must ensure proper disposal of coyote.

While it is best that carcasses are allowed to naturally decompose in appropriate areas, the participant must ensure these guidelines are followed.

- Carcasses may not be disposed on public or private property without expressed permission from the landowner.
- Carcasses may not be disposed of in a dumpster without expressed permission of dumpster owner.
- Disposing of carcasses along roadsides, right-of-ways, creeks, lakes, rivers, and other waterways is unlawful.
- Most landfills will accept animal carcasses for disposal. However, it is always best to call your county landfill for any specific preparation (i.e. bagging of animal, etc.).
- Local solid waste departments may pick up animal carcasses. Please contact your local county solid waste department or public works office for any specific preparation (i.e. bagging of animal, etc.).
