Caddie Policy: Caddies ages 7 to 13 are allowed at all GSPJT events. Each player shall designate their caddie before starting the first round. Caddies may be replaced by the player at any time. Players can have only one caddie at a time. All players must walk and carry their clubs or use a caddie during competition. Players and Caddies may use pull carts. A player with a physical disability may be exempt from this policy. Contact the GSPJT Tour Director with any questions.

Cart/Spectator Policy:

1. Spectators and parents and golf carts must stay on the cart path at all times.
2. Cell phones must be kept in vibrate or silent mode at all times.
3. Phone use must be kept to a minimum to avoid distracting players.
4. Spectators may carry water, food, clothing, etc. for the players.
5. Spectators are not allowed to give advice to the players.

PLAYERS MAY BE PENALIZED FOR Rule 8-1 in the USGA Rules of Golf.

“Advice is any counsel or suggestion, which could influence a player in determining his/her play, the choice of club or the method of making a stroke. Information on the Rules or public information, such as course yardage, course hazards or hole locations is not advice.

6. Spectators are encouraged to help search for lost golf balls.
7. Spectators, Parents and Caddies must stay clear of the scoring tent following play. The players are responsible for their hole by hole scores. The scoring totals will be tallied by the GSPJT scoring staff.

PACE OF PLAY POLICY: The GSPJT shall enforce the USGA Rules of Golf, Rule 6-7. “The player must play without undue delay.” The penalty for breach of this rule is two strokes in stroke play and loss of hole in match play. The GSPJT will educate players and caddies and enforce policy to maintain the integrity of the game.

Players out of position will receive a verbal warning and asked to pick up the pace. They will be timed to facilitate faster play. Failure to improve pace may require penalizing one player or all players in the group, depending on the situation. The goal is to keep pace with the group in front of you. When you cannot see the group ahead, then you are out of position.
