Amicalola Creek	<a href="#">Dawson County, Dawson Forest WMA</a>	Fishing Platform	From Dawsonville, go west on GA-53 for 6 miles. Turn right just before crossing the bridge.	Stocked monthly from November-mid-May, then twice a month through Labor Day. <b>This area is designated delayed harvest and special regulations apply including catch and release from 11/1 through 5/14.</b>
Chattahoochee River	<a href="#">Gwinnett County, Don White Memorial Park</a>	Fish Pier	From GA-400, go east on Holcomb Bridge Road for 1/4 mile, turn right onto Old Alabama Road, then right on Riverside Drive. Park entrance on left.	Weekly from the end of March to Labor Day.
Chattahoochee River	<a href="#">Cobb County, Cochran Shoals</a>	Fishing Piers	Use Interstate North Parkway to access parking for Cochran Shoals Trail on west side of the river.	Stocked monthly from November-mid-May. <b>This area is designated delayed harvest and special regulations apply including catch and release from 11/1 through 5/14.</b>
Johns Creek	<a href="#">Floyd County, near the Pocket Recreation Area</a>	Fish Pier	10 miles north on Everett Springs Road from the intersection of Everett Springs Road and GA-156, parking area on left.	Weekly from the end of March to Labor Day.
Lake Blueridge Tailwater (Toccoa River)	<a href="#">Fannin County, Tammen Park</a>	Fishing Platform	Traveling east from Blue Ridge on US-76 turn right on to park access road just before you cross the river.	Weekly from the end of March to Labor Day.
Little Amicalola Creek	<a href="#">Dawson County, Amicalola Falls State Park</a>	Sidewalk	Reflection pool located at the Amicalola Falls trailhead. State park pass required.	Stocked twice a month from the end of March until Labor Day.
Moccasin Creek	<a href="#">Rabun County, Moccasin Creek State Park</a>	Fishing Piers	From Clarksville travel 19 miles north on GA-197. Trout fishing is restricted to kids, seniors, and people possessing a Georgia disability fishing license.	Weekly from the end of March to Labor Day.
Smith Creek	<a href="#">White County, Unicoi State Park</a>	Fishing Platform	Turn on Anna Ruby Falls Road off GA-356 and look for picnic shelter #6. A state park is required.	Weekly from the end of March to Labor Day.
Tallulah River	<a href="#">Rabun County, near Tallulah River Campground</a>	Fish Pier	Head north on Persimmon Road off of US-76, after 4 miles turn left on Tallulah River Road. Fishing pier will be on your left before Tallulah River Campground.	Weekly from the end of March to Labor Day.
Toccoa River	<a href="#">Fannin County, Deep Hole Recreation Area</a>	Fishing Platform	From Blue Ridge, take US-76 east for 5 miles to Morganton. Turn right on GA-60 and go south for 16 miles. Turn right onto recreation area access road.	Weekly from the end of March to Labor Day.
Vogel Lake	<a href="#">Union County, Vogel State Park</a>	Fishing Platform	From Blairsville travel 11 miles south on GA-129, Turn right into the park.	Stocked twice a month from the end of March until June and three times in the fall.

Boggs Creek	<a href="#">Lumpkin County, Boggs Creek Recreation Area</a>	12 miles north of Cleveland on GA-129, turn right on Boggs Creek Road.	Weekly from the end of March to Labor Day.
Chattahoochee River	<a href="#">Forsyth County, Buford Dam, Lower Pool Park</a>	From GA-400 turn onto Buford Dam Road and go 4.5 miles and follow signs for East Lower Pool Park.	Weekly from the end of March to Labor Day.
Chattahoochee River	<a href="#">White County, Helen area</a>	Riverside Park located off Edelweiss Stasse Drive	Weekly from the end of March to July 4th.
Cooper Creek	<a href="#">Union County, Cooper Creek WMA</a>	From GA-60 take Cooper Creek Road to Mulky Gap Road. Look for signs for the Cooper Creek Recreation Area.	Weekly from the end of March to Labor Day.
Dockery Lake	<a href="#">Lumpkin County, Dockery Creek Recreation Area</a>	From Dahlonega travel north on GA-60 approximately 13 miles and turn right on FS-654, travel 1 mile to Dockery Lake Recreation Area.	Stocked 6 times from March until July 4th.
Holly Creek	<a href="#">Murray County, Holly Creek Picnic Area</a>	Follow Old CCC Camp Road until the end and changes to Holly Creek Road (FS-18) parking area on left.	Weekly from the end of March to Labor Day.
Low Gap Creek	<a href="#">White County, Low Gap Campground</a>	Take Popular Stump Road north off of ALT GA-75 approximately 4.5 miles.	Weekly from the end of March to Labor Day.

Owltown Creek	<a href="#">Gilmer County, Rich Mountain WMA</a>	Take GA--52 from US-76 for 1.3 miles towards Amicalola State Park then turn left on Owltown Creek Road.	Twice a month from end of March until Labor Day.
Panther Creek	<a href="#">Panther Creek, Stephens County</a>	From Toccoa head north on GA 184 for 5 miles and stay left on Yonah Dam Road. Then another 5 miles turn left on Panther Creek Road.	Weekly from the end of March to July 4th.
Rock Creek	<a href="#">Fannin County, near Chattahoochee Forest National Fish Hatchery</a>	Travel 4.5 miles on Rock Creek Road off GA-60 near Suches, Georgia.	Weekly from the end of March to Labor Day.
Toccoa River	<a href="#">Fannin County, Horseshoe Bend Park</a>	Traveling north on GA-60 towards McCaysville turn left on River Road park will be on the left.	Weekly from the end of March to Labor Day.
Warwoman Creek	<a href="#">Rabun County, near Clayton</a>	From Cayton take Warwoman Road 8 miles east, turn left on Earls Ford Road and travel 1 mile. USFS property begins after the bridge crossing Warwoman Creek.	Weekly from the end of March to Labor Day.
